

Substitute Teacher Qualifications:

In order to qualify to be a substitute teacher in West Virginia you must hold a minimum of a Bachelors Degree. If your degree is not in education, you will need to receive the substitute teacher training

which you can register for at www.epicresa8.org for classroom training in which there is a fee. You may also take the online training through WV learns which is free of charge

After the training you will be required to observe in the classroom for a total of six hours divided among elementary, middle, and high school. Once you have completed these requirements, you will qualify for a substitute teacher permit through W. V. Dept. of Education in which forms, transcripts, and fingerprinting will be required.
